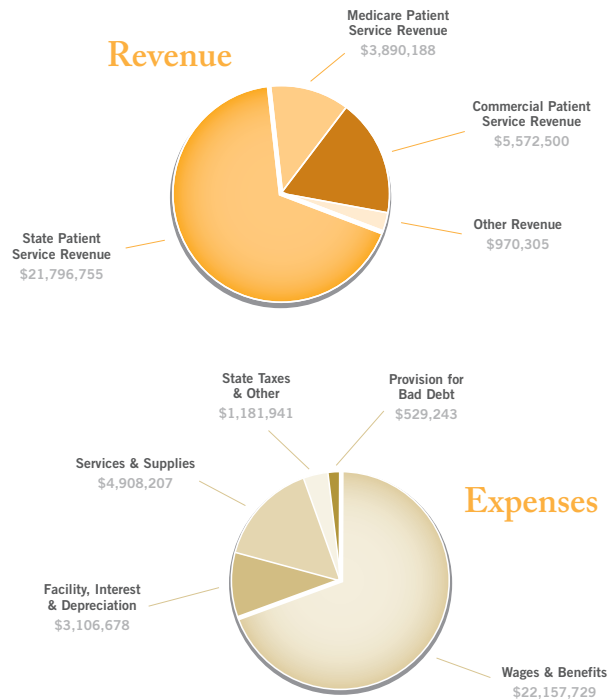
- Health education programs on topics like stress management, living with bipolar disorder, and substance abuse prevention
